



## Community Egg Hunt FAQs

**The time says 10-12, but different times for the hunts? I'm confused.**

Yes! We have LOTS of activities for you and your family to participate in at this year's Community Easter Egg Hunt, so you'll have time to do that anywhere from 10am to 12pm. But each age group will have their own egg hunt at three different times: 10:30am, 11:00 am, & 11:30am. You'll get a wrist band to hunt eggs at one of those times and have the rest of the time to enjoy the festivities! This will also help if you have more than one child in a different age group. You can hunt eggs with your 1 year old at 10:30 and then join your 3rd grader at 11:00! (you get the idea)

I'm glad you asked! We'll have inflatables to get your energy out, crafts for your creative side, Big Easy Snowballs will be on site for you to purchase a cold treat, and we'll even have a petting zoo with ponies...including an Easter Llama! (it might not be a thing yet, but it WILL be!)

Use the North entrance (closest to Dorothy B. Owen Park) to park in the front lot (until it fills up) or use the rest of the parking in the back, then make your way to one of our Welcome Tables. Make sure you start there to get your child(ren)'s egg hunt wrist band. Then...HAVE FUN!
