Biblical Studies Classes

Open Bible Study: Intro to Biblical Ethics (Theory & Practice) Location: **Worship Center**

In our world, Christians are faced with new challenges related to morality and ethics. Traditional beliefs are being challenged as wrong or bigoted or irrelevant.
