Biblical Studies Classes

Open Bible Study: How to Study the Bible

Location: Worship Center • *Led by Curtis Clark and Staff*

The Bible is God's word and gift to those who are followers of Christ. Have you ever wanted to learn how to study the Bible more effectively? This class will focus on specific and practical ways to help you get more out your Bible study and give you tools for applying God's truth in your everyday life.

Spiritual Disciplines of the Christian Life

Whether you have been a Christian for 90 days or 90 years—spiritual disciplines like reading your Bible, prayer, evangelism, worship, or serving are essential. Come learn tips and techniques to get started or continue your growth in Jesus Christ. This class will be practical application on the principles of spiritual disciplines found in Donald Whitney's book *Spiritual Disciplines for the Christian Life* (book is optional).

Discipleship Classes

Men's Study: Unfolded (Eric Geiger)-Practical Theology for Men (Continuation from Session A)

Many are familiar with the great stories of the Bible, but often we miss the big picture of how they all come together to lead us to God's redemptive plan for His creation through the person of Jesus Christ. This class will help men clearly see how Jesus is the focus of all Scripture. At the conclusion of the Unfolded series (2 weeks), we will continue with the same concept, looking at the names that Jesus used to describe himself in their Old Testament context as they relate to His purpose and ministry.

Women's Study: One in a Million *(by Priscila Shrier)* **Practical Theology for Women**

Financial Peace Legacy Journey

The Legacy Journey is a seven-week class taught by Dave Ramsey and his team. They will teach you a biblical framework for growing your money, securing your family's future, and leaving a legacy for generations to come. This class will lead you deeper into investing, basic estate planning, purposeful living, safeguarding your legacy, and discovering the keys to generational wealth and true generosity. You'll learn a biblical framework for living intentionally so that you'll be able to leave a legacy that will secure your family's future and make a lasting impact on the world around you.
